THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

RECIPE FOR MONTH – Rissoles (Not Supermarket Yuk)

500gm Lean Beef (Chicken or Pork)
 ½ cup Breadcrumbs (Panko preferable)
 1 small carrot, 1 small zucchini grated into a bowl
 1 egg
 1 Large garlic clove – minced – 1 teaspoon mixed herbs
 ½ tsp Salt, ½ tsp Pepper, 2 tsp Worcester Sauce
 Grate onion into breadcrumbs & mix – add grated zucchini & carrot – mix –
 Add remaining ingredients & mix well
 Form 10 – 12 patties with dent in middle (stops cracking)
 Cook both sides for 3½ - 4 minutes on medium hot skillet - (don't overcook)
 Enjoy with Tomato sauce
